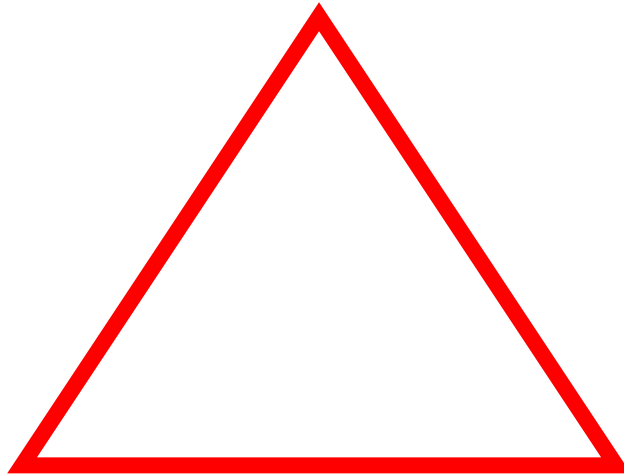


# World Mission

### What are the Reasons World Mission is Important



\_\_\_\_\_ : Jesus tells us we are to help those in need with the same spirit and dedication as if we (as if I) were actually helping Him. In Matthew 25:31-46 in the story of the sheep and goats we read: *... 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help you?' 'He will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.'*

\_\_\_\_\_ : Mission is about Sharing – Sharing the Gospel of Christ. In Mark 13:10 we read: *“And the gospel must first be preached to all nations.”* A key responsibility in our Christian life is being involved in Spreading the Good News of Jesus to ALL Nations. This is from the passage where Jesus is telling us the signs of the end of the age and gives instructions for preparation.

\_\_\_\_\_ : In 2 Corinthians 9:7-8 we read: *“Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times; having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.”* Giving is something we need to do as Christians. God gives us the heart, ability and charge to give. In this passage, Paul is giving instruction to the Church of Corinth on Sowing Generously. In the verse just before this Paul writes: *“Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.”*
